<u>Academy/ Program of Choice Scholarship (1):</u> Student must have been in one of the career academies (Aerospace Academy, St. Johns County Academy of Future Teachers, or The Academy of Law and Homeland Security), ROTC, or Center of the Arts for 3 or more years.

SA/KHS Alumni Association Academy Scholarship – Up to \$1,000; non-renewable

<u>Vocational Scholarship (1):</u> Student working towards a vocational diploma or college degree from a technical/postsecondary vocational school or college.

 SA/KHS Alumni Association Way Project Vocational Scholarship – Up to \$1,500; one year only subject to possible renewal

The SA/KHS Alumni Association's scholarship committee assesses eligible applications to determine recipients. The names of selected students are announced during Senior Award Night, and renewal details are included in the award package.

In the event that a recipient fails to graduate with the Class of '25' or provides false information in their application, the scholarship may be redirected to another student or reserved for future recipients. All funds are disbursed directly to the student's college, university, or vocational school to cover registration, tuition, books, lab fees, and other specified expenses.
